

Solimon-Sturm To Run on WEALTH

SAN DIEGO, CA –February 5th 2013 - *WealthTV* has secured the rights to air the bout between the WBA #2 contender Felix Sturm (37-3, 16KO) and the IBF #1 contender Sam Soliman (42-11, 17KO). The contest received 5 out of 5 star rating from BoxRec.com.

WealthTV will air the fight on February 14th at 10 PM ET during *WealthTV*'s usual Thursday "Fight Night" time slot. It will be the first airing of the February 1st

fight in the United States.

The bout was the first non-title fight for Sturm since 2007 as he looked to bounce back from a tough loss against Soliman's fellow Australian, Daniel Geale. Soliman put his title on the line twelve times before finally losing it to Geale.

Soliman needed to win this fight in order to put himself in line for an all-Australian IBFtitle fight against Daniel Geale. Geale successfully defended his title against another Aussie, Anthony Mundine, a day before.
