DANIA BEACH, Fla.—Many of the principal fighters on Saturday's "Viva Don King" world championship card in Hard Rock Live at the Seminole Hard Rock Hotel & Casino (WealthTV 8 p.m. ET/PT) participated in a media workout today in Dania Beach, Fla.

Guillermo "El Felino" Jones (37-3-2, 29 KOs) will defend his WBA cruiserweight title in the main event against WBA No. 14-ranked Mike Marrone (20-3, 15 KOs), from Vero Beach, Fla.

"I'm actually very relaxed during this fight week as I've done all my work and now I know what I am going to do," Jones said before his workout. "My message to Mike Marrone is simple: Don't make it harder than it has to be. Don't make me hurt you more than I have to. Don't be too brave."

USBO junior middleweight champion Joey "Twinkle Fingers" Hernandez (19-1-1, 11 KOs), a Miami native, will take on Elco "The Animal" Garcia (25-7, 12 KOs) with the vacant WBC U.S. super welterweight championship on the line.

"Elco Garcia is a typical Mexican fighter in that he comes right at you," Hernandez said. "His problem is that he is one-dimensional. That's perfect for me. I'm too young, too fast and explosive for my opponent. This fight will not go the distance."
