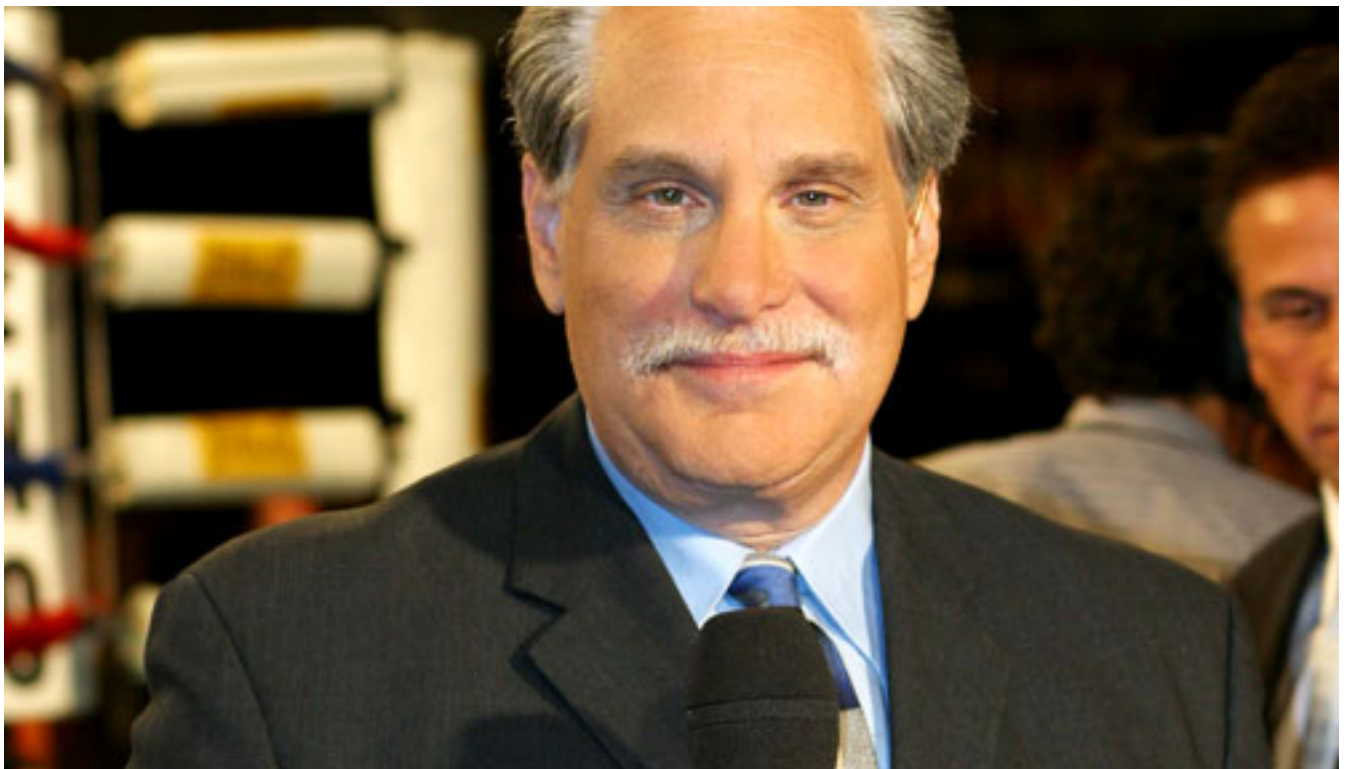


Al Bernstein Calls Ward-Froch A "Fitting End" To the Year In Boxing
