The dinner serves as the primary fundraiser of the year for the Foundation, allowing the not-for-profit community service organization to continue providing financial and emotional support to individuals and organizations in need, focusing particularly on the needs of children.

"It's wonderful that we have been able to put on this event for 15 years running now, and it is an honor to have all of these tremendous athletes, coaches, and other celebrities involved, who have been willing to give their time and money to support our cause over many years," said Atlas.

"There is much work to be done - many mouths to help feed and sick children to help care for - and we are privileged to have the opportunity to do that important work. We couldn't do it without the support of all of these great people who come to the Teddy Dinner."

This year's supporters will not only have the chance to mix and mingle with the dozens of celebrities in attendance at the dinner, but also contribute funds to the foundation through live and silent auctions.
