Demyanenko looks to continue his march up the welterweight rankings and add another win to his undefeated record. With a possible TV fight looming for the Russian born standout, Vitaliy is looking to make a statement against Frias.

"Training camp is complete and I'm excited to be fighting in the main event this Saturday," said

Demyanenko

. "I know Fraias is coming to fight but there's nothing he can do that is going to surprise me. My trainer and I have studied his tapes and we've put together a masterful game plan to counter his attack. My goal in this fight is to get the knockout, but I'm prepared to go the distance if I have too."

"Vitaliy is ready to go and I expect him to have a great performance against Fraias," stated Demyanenko's manager **Steve Pochiro**. "The ultimate goal is to position Demyanenko into the top ten of all sanctioning organizations by early next year."

"Demyanenko is making a lot of noise right now in the welterweight division," says **Boxing 360** promoter

Mario Yagobi

. "His name is big in Russia where he was born and raised and he's been getting better with each fight. He's got a bright future as long as he keeps winning, which I anticipate him to do."
